We have worked and will continue to work tirelessly to restore MIND back to an enviable position in the committee of National Organizations in Minnesota. We are working hard to meet the needs of our people. We help those that are in desperate need of family help and support. Recently, we prevented the deportation of one of our country men to another country even when he was ready to go back to

Nigeria due a health challenge by facilitating his smooth and empathic return to his family before his deportation date, and we also facilitated his rehabilitation back at home. We hope he will soon be in the position to return to the US to come and complete his doctoral degree if he chooses to. I will like to thank everyone and organizations in the community who contributed towards this assignment. May the God continue to increase you.

MIND, with the support of some members of our community also spearheaded the burial of the husband of one of our international students who suddenly died after a brief illness while he was visiting his wife. He was buried here immediately in total respect of his religious belief and right after due consultation with his family. We represent and proudly hoist our Green-White-Green flag at international events along other immigrant communities where only the national organizations of these communities are invited. Our members are encouraged to explore and invest back home, many opportunities are abound in Nigeria. We walk slowly but surely stronger together with one purpose so that no one is left behind. We try to avoid past mistakes, by doing away with any non-progressive ideas, and embrace new and progressive ideas instead. On our part as the executives of the organization, we are servant leaders, we are leading the organization with a laser focused transparency and accountability. These were the only things I promised the community during the campaign before I was elected as the president along with my wonderful executive members. So far so good, our approach is working as old MIND members are returning, new and young members are also joining this Nigerians umbrella organization.

MIND is for all Nigerians living in Minnesota, and with the increased of the numbers of active members comes with increase logistic responsibilities. For instance, we know that many of our tribal and community organizations are doing fantastic job in their immediate communities back home in Nigeria, they know their native communities better, hence, we would continue to rely on them in this regard, but we need to be in the position to give them the necessary support. We are currently working towards the acquisition of a Nigerian Community and Cultural Center (The Nigerian House), a center that will serve as a home away from home to every Nigerian in the state of Minnesota. It will serve as resource center to people that want to know about Nigeria, a place where our elderly parents can meet daily for appropriate programs rather than using the television for companionship while we go to work. It will be a hub where our youths can meet and learn about our multi-cultural customs, foods, history, and our way of life, so that they can uphold our cultural heritage. Nigeria is proudly home to about three hundred ethnicities in the heart of West Africa, and the most populous black nation on earth.

On behalf of the MIND family, I would like to thank some of our community members that have donated money towards this project (The Nigerians House), those who have pledged annual donation and have promised to continue to do so until we achieve our aim, and those who have promised to answer our call. Let us walk together, though we may be slow but together we will achieve our set goal. Let us remember that our unity is our strength. With Nigerian Americans and American Nigerians, we are about 22000 strong in Minnesota. Let us put our strength to work, God will help us.

PROFILE OF THE 18TH CHIEF OF DEFENCE STAFF ARMED FORCES OF NIGERIA

General Christopher Gwabin Musa was born on December 25, 1967, in Sokoto State in northwest Nigeria, he hails from Zangon Kataf Local Government Area of Kaduna State. He had his elementary and secondary education in Sokoto State despite coming from Kaduna State. In 1986, the distinguished Senior Officer proceeded to the Nigerian Defence Academy, Kaduna for his military training. General CG Musa was commissioned as a second lieutenant into the Infantry Corps of the Nigerian Army as member of the 38th Regular Course on 21 September 1991. Since his commissioned, General Musa has attended several military and civil courses amongst which are the Mechanical Transportation Officers Course – 1992; Young Officers Course (Infantry) – 1993; Regimental Signal Officers Course – 1998; Junior Staff Course at the Armed Forces Command and Staff College Jaji – 2000; Senior Staff Course at the Armed Forces

Command and Staff College Jaji – 2004 – 2005; Advance Diploma in Defence and Strategies Course (China) – International; College of Defense Studies National Defense University (ICDS-NDU) – Chang Ping China 2013, MSc (Military Science) – ICDS-BDU (China) – 2013; National Defence College at ICDS (China) – 2013 and the Combined Joint Land Component Commander's Course on Leadership at the US Army War College – 2017.

In the course of his career, General CG Musa has held several appointments, amongst them are Platoon Commander at 192 Bn in 1991; Intelligence Officer at 192 Bn from 1993 to 1994; Administrative Officer at 2 Div Camp (Garrison) from 1995 to 1999; Pioneer Adjutant 195 Bn – 2000; Operations Officer – NIBATT 8 UNAMSIL between 2001 to 2002; 195 Bn 2ic from 2002 to 2003; 149 Bn 2ic from 2005 to 2006; General Staff Officer 1 Training/Operations at HQ 81 Division 2006 to 2007; Commanding Officer 73 Bn from 2007 to 2009; Assistant Director Operational Requirement at Department of Army Policy and Plans from 2009 to 2011; Infantry Representative/Member Training Team at HQ Nigerian Army Armour Corps – 2011 to 2012; Deputy Chief of Staff Training/Operations at HQ Infantry Centre and Corp – 2013 to 2014. Chief

of Staff at HQ 2 Division – 2014 to 2015; Commandant Depot Nigerian Army – 2015 to 2017; Principal Staff Officer (Combat Arms) at Army HQ Department of Projects and Programmes – 2017, Pioneer Executive Director Nigerian Army Farms and Ranches Ltd – 2017, Commander 82 Division Task Force Brigade OP LAST HOLD in the North East – 2018; Commander Sector 3 OP LAFIYA DOLE – 2019; Comd Sect 3 Multinational Joint Task Force in the Lake Chad Region – 2019; Chief of General Duties TRADOC – 2019 to 2020; Director Campaign Planning AHQ DATOPs – 2020; Director Training AHQ-DATOPs – 2020; Senior Research Fellow, Nigerian Army Resource Centre – 2021; Theatre Comd JTF (NE) Op HADIN KAI 2022 and Commander, Infantry Corps, an appointment he held from January 2023 till his appointment by the President as the 18th Chief of Defence Staff. General Musa is the immediate past Chairman of ECOWAS Chiefs of Defence Staff.

In terms of successes recorded in Operations General Chris Musa, as the Theatre Commander for “Operation Hadin Kai,” ensured that his troops reclaimed the upper hand after more than ten years of fighting Islamist insurgents in the northeast. His tenure saw the troops decimate many insurgents while many others surrendered to the sustained fighting power of the troops which deny the insurgents freedom of action in the general area of the operation. Other Operations attended by the Senior Officer include OP MESA; OP SECOND HEAVEN; OP FOCUS RELIEF, (Joint Training/Ops with the US Troops) – 2000; United Nation Mission in Sierra Leone from 2001 – 2002; OP HAKURI – 2002 to 2003; OP SAFE CONDUCT – 2007; OP RESTORE HOPE – 2007 to 2008; OP SAFE CONDUCT – 2015; OP AYAM APATUMEH – 2018; OP LAST HOLD – 2018; OP LAFIYA DOLE – 2019; Multi-National Joint Task Force Lake Chad – 2019; OP KANTANA JIMLAM – 2020 and JTF (NE) Op HADIN KAI – 2021.
